Application

Hygienic hand disinfection

At least 3 mL per hand, use as per the EN 1500 hand-rubbing method. Ensure complete and permanent wetting of the skin throughout the entire contact time.

Surgical hand disinfection

Effective pre-cleaning of critical areas of the skin, followed by thorough wetting by rubbing-in with decosept[®] (hands and forearms) for at least 180 seconds. The hands and forearms must be kept wet throughout the entire rubbing-in time.
